In sight

Bright, straw-yellow colour with greenish reflections.



To the nose

Clean aroma, with a high aromatic intensity on the nose, with aromas of tropical fruit and also hints of citrics.



To the mouth

Fresh, fruity and balanced acidity, with an elegant finish.



Gastronomy

Excellent aperitif and as an accompaniment to salads, mild cheeses and spreads, fish, seafood, and rice di-shes, etc.
